Summary of Significant Career Events

- (1) Twice sustained combat damage to A-4 wing, losing wing fuel returning to ship plugged in to tanker.
- (2) Combat damage - lost 2 of 3 hydraulic systems in A-7 and runaway nose down trim. Returned to ship safely.
- (3) Led 4 A-4s on intercept of three fast PT boats attacking the Northern SAR destroyer in the Gulf of Tonkin. Sunk all three on one pass. Over thirty prisoners taken by the destroyer. Valuable intelligence gained.
- (4) Led A-7 contingent in the initial mining of Hiaphong Harbor, May 1972.
- (5) As CO, NAS Fallon, initiated acquisition and environmental process for airspace, land and supersonic corridor required for eventual establishment on Naval Strike and Air Warfare Center.
