MEMORIAL SERVICE Friday, 2 May, 1630-1730

Please join us at First Presbyterian Church (one block from the hotel) for our annual Memorial Service. Written directions will be provided at the reunion

BUS TOUR Saturday, 3 May, departs hotel 1030 - 1500 return.

We will visit the POW/MIA Flame of Hope, NAS Oceana flight line, Virginia Beach Military Aviation Museum at old NAAF Pungo, and Virginia Beach Naval Aviation Monument Park

After boarding busses at the hotel, we will head off to **NAS Oceana** and stop at the **POW/MIA** "**Flame of Hope**" on Oceana Blvd. We will then go onto Oceana, first passing the NAS Memorial Park where most of the planes you flew (AD-1 Skyraider, F2H Banshee, F9F Panther, FJ-3 Fury, F4D Skyray, Blue Angel F-11F Tiger, F-8U Crusader, A-4E Skyhawk, F4H-1 Phantom II, A-6E Intruder, A-7E Corsair II, F-14 Tomcat and F/A-18A Hornet) are on display. We will then go to the flight line to meet **Air Wing and Squadron pilots** who will conduct a briefing and entertain questions on whatever your interests are. We will then head off to old **NAAF Pungo** which presently houses the **Virginia Beach Military Aviation Museum**, which has one of the largest private collections of **World War I and II era military aircraft** in the world. Each plane has been beautifully restored to its service condition. Most of the planes are airworthy and flown in flight demonstrations and air shows through the year. We will stop at 25th St on the Boardwalk to see a **Naval Aviation Monument Park**, dedicated in 2006 by The Hampton Roads Squadron of the Association of Naval Aviation (ANA). You will not want to miss it. You may also want to revisit before or after since it is just 10 blocks south of the hotel,

Cost: \$45/Person, which includes bus fare, museum admission, lunch at the Museum and driver gratuities. The cost is \$35/Person for WWII Veterans and spouses.

We need to muster for boarding at the hotel entrance at least five minutes prior to the scheduled time, which is immediately after the All Pilot's Meeting and Flight photos.
