## **Summary of Significant Career Events**

- (1) Married well above my station to a wonderful, beautiful, and patient woman. Father of five, Grandfather of four. I am a lucky man.
- (2) Flight tested prototype and full scale development FA-18A's at Pax River.
- (3) Engine testing in A-7E required proficiency in engine out landings at Edwards AFB.
- (4) Test fired first HARM missile from FA-18 at China Lake.
- (5) As CARGRU staffer, planned Bering Sea flight operations conducted in treacherous winter conditions.
- (6) Deployed as a unit of MAG-15 to Iwakuni, Japan during the first deployment in DH FA-18A squadron (VFA-132)
- (7) During 1989 deployment on USS *Coral Sea*, flew in support of short notice emergency airborne evacuation of US embassy in Lebanon.
- (8) Assumed immediate command of VFA-37 when CO was lost in an aircraft mishap.
- (9) With VFA-37, supported relief flights in embattled Bosnia-Hercegovina during the 1993 JFK cruise.
- (10) As CO CVN71, deployed to North Arabian Sea days after 9/11/2001 to begin combat flight operations against the Taliban. Deployed in 2003 after a six month yard period with only two months of training and with a new Airwing to support Operation Iraqi Freedom. During two combat cruises, expended over 1.5 million pounds of ordnance.

- (11) With the Joint Forces Command Standing Joint Force HQ, deployed numerous times to Afghanistan, Djibuti and Iraq to plan combat and surveillance operations.
- (12) Trained every deploying Atlantic Fleet CVN and LHD during tour as COM Strike Force Training Atlantic, now known as CARGRU Four.
