Summary of Significant Career Events

- (1) Selected by VT-23 CO, CDR W H Lowans, as one of two initial PlowBack instructors to the squadron.
- (2) One in the initial group of VF-121 transition pilots to move with the Tactics Detachment to the temporary TOPGUN trailer at NAS Miramar. 1969
- (3) Qualified, Landing Signal Officer (LSO) May 1970 Aboard CVA-66 during the 1970 around the World Cruise. SHELLBACK (24 April 1970)
- (4) The sole participant in initial night carrier CAT 3 ACLS tests aboard CVA-66 (1970). Perhaps selected for limited appreciation of the challenges involved.
- (5) Flight Lead, Target Combat Air Patrol (TARCAP) in the most significant and longest air engagement of the Vietnam War. Destroyed two MIG-17s on same flight 10 May 1972 This engagement changed the direction of Naval Aviation Fighter Pilot tactics for the future. 1972 was the most active period of North Vietnam's Air Force and air defenses toward US Forces of the war.
