- 5. While attached to USSPACECOM, screened for VFA command. Was slated as XO/CO of VFA-37 when selected by NASA to join the 1995 Astronaut Class.

- 7. Following the loss of the STS-107 crew aboard Columbia, coordinated and led the search for all Columbia parts and material. NASA worked with FEMA and the US Forest Service to recover 40% of the shuttle's mass along with the data recorder, allowing an accurate accident reconstruction, subsequent modifications and return-to-flight. More than 25,000 searchers participated. More than 2 million acres searched.
